Registration: Online at www.zone4.ca closing June 28, 23:00. Single Event License will **not** be available. Riders must present a valid UCI or ABA 2014 Race license.

Number Placement: Two numbers, right shoulder, right lower back + frame plate

Sprint Challenge Race Details

License Check & Sign-on:

- ✦ Sign on closes 30 minutes before the start of all events
- ✦ Schedule will be posted 15 minutes before 6pm. (first heat)

Schedule:

The times will be varied based on the number of heats and the time needed to put heats together as the event continues through the night.

Race Format:

- ✦ All riders will be guaranteed one race only.
- ✦ Top two from each heat of four will advance to the next heats.
- ✦ The course will be the last 500 meters on the Criterium course.

Race Route: We will be using the criterium course. The start will be on [54 Ave.](#) near the elementary school and the finish will be the same as the Criterium. See map on page 5.

ABA Upgrade Points: No upgrade points will be awarded for the sprint challenge event.

Food and Drink: There will be no support during the sprint challenge.

First Aid: There will be no first aid. U of A hospital is 10 minutes north (Call 911)

Washrooms: We will have portable toilets at the finish line only. There will also be toilets in the community hall near the finish area. Please no public urination, you may be disqualified from event.

Race Format:

- ✦ The race will be a points format. Points will be awarded every 4 laps. 5, 3, 2 & 1 points to the 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th place rider across the line.
- ✦ Riders lapping the field will be a lap up and all riders will finish on the same lap as the leader.
- ✦ A bell will be rung at the beginning of each sprint lap. Points will only be awarded if the bell is rung.
- ✦ A bell will signify the last lap. A lap board will be used to signify the remaining laps.
- ✦ Individual riders lapped by the lead motorcycle will be pulled from the race at the discretion of the commissaire.
- ✦ There will be no feeding of riders during the race. (Riders may feed themselves :)

Regulations: This event will be run according to ABA/CC/UCI regulations. Riders are responsible for knowing and understanding the rules. They are available [online](#).

Wheel Pit: Wheel pit is located south of the start / finish area. It is the rider's responsibility to supply wheels identified by your race number. In the case of a crash or mechanical difficulty you must report to the commissaire in the wheel pit. No free laps will be given in the last 3 laps of the race.

First Aid: Emergency services will be on site. See course map. The nearest hospital is the [University of Alberta Hospital](#) (8440 112 St NW). Use 911 in an emergency.

Parking: on south side of 53 Ave and cul-de-sac at SE end of course.

Washrooms: There will two portable toilets near the start finish and there are washrooms at the community hall. Please do not urinate in the community grounds.

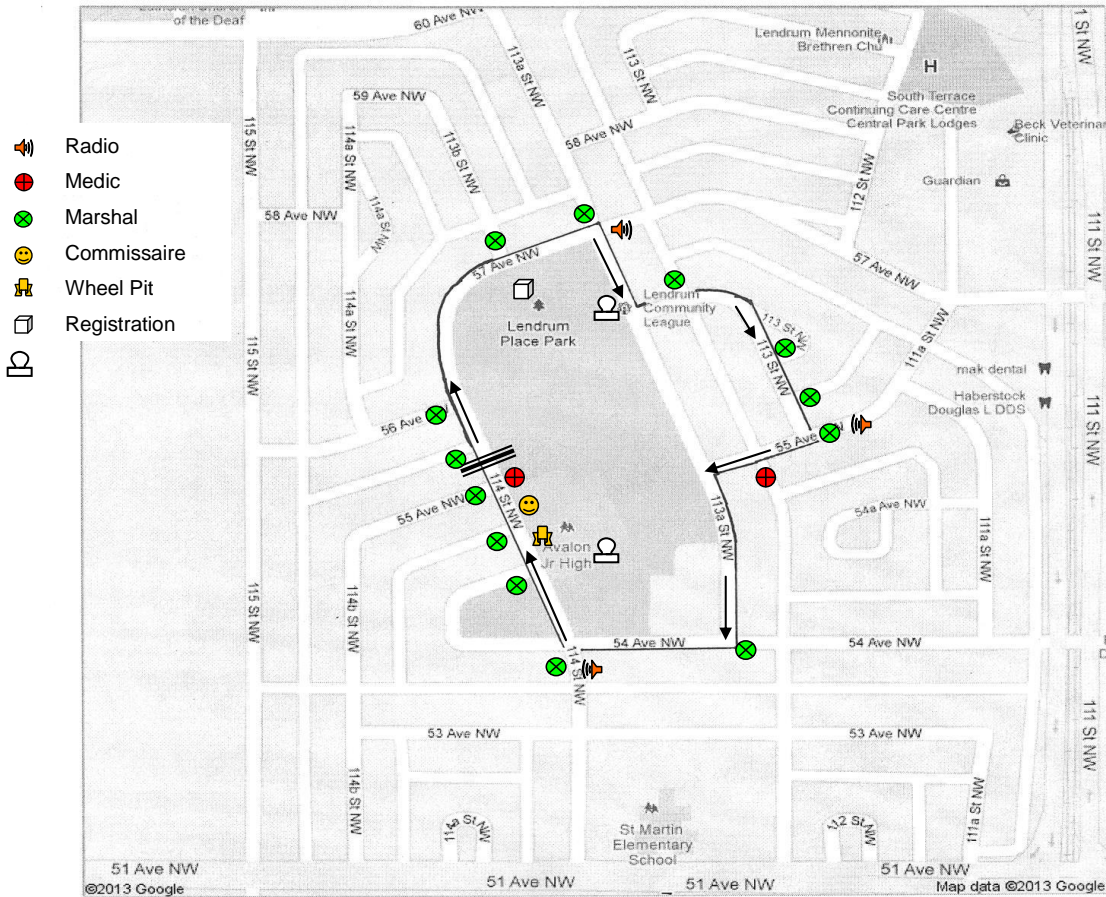
Food & Drink:

Race entry includes burger and pop. Beer is \$4 per cup. Additional food is available to spectators at a cost of \$5 for a burger and pop to support Lendrum Playground.

Awards: Presentations for each race will be held at the start / finish area during the mustering for the next race. Cash prizes and store gift cards.

ABA Points: This event will be part of the ABA Road Series with series and upgrade points available according to the ABA points schedule B (20, 15, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2, 1).
