



2015 Lino Bovo Track Meet June 20 and 21, 2015

The Juventus Cycling Club, Argyll Velodrome Association and Argyll Velodrome Racing Academy host the Lino Bovo Track Meet at the Argyll Velodrome on June 20 and 21. This is a provincially sanctioned event with results counting towards the Journal Cup. See <http://www.argyllvelodrome.com> for directions to the track.

Categories:

Competitive categories will be A, B, C, and D. This event is a Journal Cup Event.

Entry:

Cost - \$50 **Pre-registration is required – + \$15 for Single Event Licence.**
U 17 - \$25 **Pre-registration is required – Including Single Event Licence.**

Registration will be on www.zone4.com until 11:59pm, Friday, June 19. There will be no race day registration. All racers must hold valid ABA/CCA/UCI licenses. Single Event Licences will be available. Race numbers will be provided. Frame plates are not required.

You must indicate all races you plan to enter since start lists will be prepared prior to the event to better organize the race days.

Prizes:

Merchandise prizes will be awarded to winners in each category.

The awards ceremony will be held at the end of racing on Sunday.

Other:

Lunch will be provided to all racers at the end of racing on Sunday (approximately 2:30 PM).

Events:

Pursuit, sprint, scratch, kilo/500, points and keirin,
Out-of-Competition: 5/10 miler/Madison.

Program:

Approximate start times will be posted on the Argyll Velodrome Association website (www.argyllvelodrome.com/track2015) website on Saturday morning for all events, including start lists and times for pursuits, sprint qualifying and kilo/500. Times will be subject to change for rain delays, if any.

Regulations:

Races will be run according to ABA/CCC/UCI regulations as published here:

Saturday:

11:30 AM – Sign-on.

- **You must sign on 30 minutes before your first event.** This means that sprinters who aren't doing the pursuit should arrive 2:00pm at the latest.

12:30 PM – Track opens for warm-up

1:00 PM – Pursuits

3:00 PM – Sprint qualifying straight into rounds 1 & 2 (single ride off)

5:00 PM – Scratch races

5:45 PM – Remaining sprint rounds

Break

9:30 PM – Open 5 mile

10:00 PM – Open ten mile scratch

Sunday:

8:00 AM – Track opens

9:00 AM – Kilo/500, points races, keirins (6 laps - A/B/C)

12:00 Awards

Race distances (may change depending on field sizes):

	Pursuit	Scratch	Kilo/500	Points
A	4000 m	40 laps	Kilo	75 laps
B	3000 m	25 laps	500	48 laps
C	2000 m	15 laps	500	25 laps
D	2000 m	10 laps	500	20 laps

Distances have been set to help riders prepare for nationals, where races are relatively long. The organizers may shorten race distances and/or combine groups if field sizes are small.
