The end of the Alberta Cyclocross Cup series brings us to Calgary for the Provincial Championships in memory of our friend Brian Kullman, a beloved member of the cycling community and a superfan of cyclocross.

The Where and When

Located at [2116 MacKay Rd](#), the schoolyard at Montgomery Jr. High is for a third time, the site of the BKM. Follow 16th Ave (Trans Canada Highway) West, exit onto Bowness Road and take your first right on 42 Street. The school is at the end of the block. While this course runs a little short on length, it is long on technical challenges.

Technical

The weather tends to cool off a little by November so arrangements have been made for us to use the school's main gym for post race formalities. Showers are available as well.

Plenty of parking is available at the front of the school. Try to avoid parking on MacKay Road if you can. Please do not drag bikes through the school lobby. The best outdoor access to the course is on the North side of the building. Please, **NO CLEATS in the school, **NO DIRTY** footwear of any type beyond the foyers. I know everyone is a responsible pet owner but please leave your dog at home. They are not welcome on school property. Once again the Calgary School Board has been very accommodating. The facility is very expensive to rent and we would like to maintain a good relationship.**

While very spectator friendly, the race course is built in a very confined space. It is impossible to access the best viewing locations without crossing or traveling along the course. Use caution while moving around the yard and remind your fans to do the same.

A wheel pit, accessible twice per lap, will be located in the lower playing field. Please remember to collect your wheels and or bicycles at the end of your race.

There will be plenty of time between races for practice laps so please do not ride the course while races are in progress. Riders must wear helmets during pre/post race riding at the race venue.

Pin your numbers on your right side.
