

Commissaire Recruitment Program

In 2010, we will be continuing with the Commissaire Recruitment Program initiated in 2004. The amount your club owes for the CRP is already written on your 2010 Club Application Form. The total number of commissaires each club will have to provide throughout the year is based on the number of licensed racers the club held in the prior year. Commissaire courses will be offered in the spring. Clubs who do not provide their required number of commissaries by the end of the racing season will forfeit their bond. BMX licenses and General Membership Licenses will not be included in the 'licensed racers' count. The Commissaire Recruitment Policy is as follows:

3.3.2.2 Commissaire Recruitment Program

- a) Each Alberta club with at least 5 licensed racing members must provide a number of commissaires according to the chart below. Clubs (or the individuals taking the course) will be responsible for the costs associated with completing the Commissaire training course.

Racing Members	Commissaire Days
5-15	2
16-30	4
31+	6

- b) Performance Bond – Each club will be responsible for providing a performance bond of \$50 for each of their two Commissaire days. Once the Commissaire/s from their club has officiated their required number of events, the bond will be returned to the club. Defaulted bonds would be put into the Commissaire budget.

Clubs may fill their commissaire quota with:

- Existing licensed Commissaires
- Commissaires who have taken the training but who have been inactive
- New Commissaires
