Junior Canadian Road Championships

Location: Levis QC

Dates: June 26-June 29, 2020

Team Size

The desired team size will be 4 females and 4 male athletes. The ABA reserves the right to vary the team size of the project based on interest level, athlete performance level and logistical considerations.

Selection Date

Notification of selection to the team will be made the week of May 25th.

Eligibility

To be eligible for selection to the team athletes must:

- Possess a current ABA license;
- Be less than 19 years of age and at least 17 years of age as of December 31st, 2020.
- Demonstrate commitment to Team Alberta and the road cycling.

Selection Criteria

Athletes will be selected to the Road Nationals objectively by points, and subjectively by committee selection. Selection will be made in the following priority:

Junior Men

1. 1st on Points
2. 2nd on Points
3. Committee selection
4. Committee selection

Junior Women

1. 1st on Points
2. 2nd on Points
3. Committee selection
4. Committee selection

Selection by Road Points

The female and male athlete with the greatest number of road selection points will be awarded the 1st and 2nd selection position. Road selection points will be earned in the Stieda Classic, May 9-10 and the Hay City Classic, May 23rd. Points can only be obtained in Category 2 for Men and Category 2 for Women and will be awarded by placing as indicated in Table 1. Ties will be broken based on placing position in the time trial in the Velocity Stage Race.
