REGISTRATION AND LICENSING:

Registration Opens: September 18th 8:00am at www.zone4.ca

Registration Early bird fee until **OCTOBER 10th** - **\$40**

After OCTOBER 10th registration increases to **\$50**

Registration Closes Thursday OCTOBER 19TH at 11:59 pm

All riders competing in the Junior and U17 Provincial Cross Championship categories must have a valid UCI license. There will be no day licenses issued for Junior and U17 categories. All riders competing in the U15 and U13 category must have either a valid UCI license, a valid Alberta Citizen License (available to residents of Alberta only), or an Alberta day license (available to Alberta and out-of-province racers). Please note that a rider may compete with an Alberta-issued Day License in U15 and U13 Only.

One-day event licenses are available onsite only and are \$10 (cash only). Racers competing under a 'Day License' will require a parent to complete a waiver at sign-on prior to competition.

License check will be held under the ABA tent, beginning at 9 am. All riders must sign on at registration with a valid 2017 ABA or UCI license 15 minutes prior to category start time. Failure to bring your license may result in a \$10 fine.

CATEGORIES:

CYCLING CANADA categories and UCI Regulations for Cyclocross place riders in their respective category for the following year, as the international Cyclocross calendar comprises two calendar years. Categories may be combined at the discretion of the Chief Commissaire, however podiums will be awarded by category.

RELAY: A team of 4

Team Relay Composition: We have developed a simple points system that is used to build a team. Each category of rider is assigned a Points value, and all 4 riders on the team must add up to a maximum of 275 points.

NUMBERS

Please bring your 2018 Alberta Cyclocross numbers with you. If this is your first cross race of the season, the ABA will provide you with numbers on race day.

In CX races, numbers must be placed on each shoulder and then centered on the lower back as shown in the image below. Please place large number as low as possible.

REGULATIONS AND EQUIPMENT:

This event will be run according to ABA/CC/UCI regulations. Riders are responsible for knowing and understanding the rules. Rules and regulations can be found online [here](#).

MECHANICAL ZONE: The bike/wheel pit will be located near the start/finish area. A Course Marshal will be stationed at the pit. Please label your equipment and remember to collect it. Equipment is NOT neutral. Bow Cycle will be on site to manage all your race day emergencies and needs, and can get you tuned up and race ready if you want to prevent those last-minute fixes.

BIKES: Cyclocross bicycles must be used for riders competing in the Junior category. Mountain bikes are permitted in U17, U15 & U13.

COURSE: Will be as close to 3k as we can get. The city has given us more space! The two  marks show where the course will leave the Velodrome and take on more terrain.

CALL UPS

There will be call-ups for Junior and U17 categories five minutes before the start of their events. Top 8 will be called up based upon current UCI standing followed by current Alberta Cup standing.

AWARDS

Provincial Cyclocross Championships Medals will be awarded in the following National categories at the Provincial Championship Cyclocross:

- Junior Men
- Junior Women
- U17 Men
- U17 Women
- Categories may be combined for racing purposes. Medals, however, will be awarded to riders in each of the above categories where applicable.
- All other age categories will be awarded per race (if combined) and acknowledged for their performance,

ANTIDOPING

The ABA complies with and fully supports the UCI antidoping regulations, the clauses of the World Antidoping Code and its international Standards to which the UCI antidoping regulation refer and to the antidoping regulations of other competent bodies as per the regulations of the UCI.

WEATHER ISSUES

Due to unpredictable Alberta weather we won't know race conditions until the day of. The City of Calgary does not permit the racing of bicycles on primary parks however the grass we are riding on is not part of a primary park or field. We will do our best to race in whatever the day brings us. Again, we are at the mercy of the City of Calgary and they do have the power to cancel the event last minute.
