Volunteer Job Descriptions (brief):

Course Marshals

Work with event staff to manage traffic and crowd control on race course. Technical Director will create post locations. Course Marshals are placed to ensure the safety of the riders and spectators.

Media Tent/Check-in

Assist Media with press kits, check in credential media and act as a runner

Media Office

Assist Media with press kits, media office organization and act as a runner

Security

Work with event staff to manage VIP, stage, hospitality, beer garden and cross walks at start/finish area

Hospitality Start Cities

Assist staff in setting up, front door greeter and credential checking (in/out) event day guests.

Hospitality Finish Cities

Assist staff in setting up/tear down, front door greeter and credential checking (in/out) event day guests.

Volunteer Check-in

Work with local volunteer coordinator with the check in/out of volunteers and t-shirt distribution on race finish or start site.

Surveyors

Working with public, collecting Economic Impact Survey data for event, based on a questionnaire.

Parking Monitors – First shift

Manage the flow of traffic in/out of designated parking areas for VIP, Staff, Media, Teams and Spectators.

Parking Monitors – Second shift

Manage the flow of traffic in/out of designated parking area for VIP, Staff, Media, Teams and Spectators.

Anti Doping Chaperones – Non Medical

Chaperone female or male (non-medical) - serve as an athlete escort on behalf of the drug testing service. Riders are to be walked to Anti Doping location near race finish area.
