ABA Step by Step Registration Instructions

The following document is intended to assist members with purchasing their ABA license/membership through our online registration system via Zone 4. With cycling having many different disciplines and license types, registration can be confusing, hopefully this document can guide you through the process smoothly.

FAQ

1. Can I change my license after I have purchased it?

A: Yes, you can change your license at a later date. To change your license just email <u>mailto:info@albertabicycle.ab.ca</u> and let them know any changes required. If there are additional fees the credit card you used to purchase your membership initially will be charged the difference.

2. What if I belong to more than one club?

A: You only pay for your membership with ABA once. If you are part of more than one club and are registered through ABA, you can show any other club you belong to your license. Clubs may still have fee associated with their club you would need to pay directly to the club.

3. Can I get a refund?

A: Alberta Bicycle Association membership refunds are not permitted once the membership has been issued. Prior to issuance, membership applications may (at the discretion of the ABA) be cancelled minus registration provider charges.

4. How long does it take until I receive my license?

A: Licenses are now digital and will be emailed to the email provided in the registration. Depending on the time of year licenses can take up to 10 days to be processed and will only be done so once all information required is provided. If it is past 10 days please contact the ABA, the license may have gone to your junk mail or there may be an issue with the license.

5. What if information is wrong on my license?

A: The information on your license is pulled directly from the registration system. ABA only changes information regarding the licensing categories. Any incorrect information can be changed by the ABA, just send us an email and we can update and resend the license.

6. How long is my membership good for.

A: All memberships are valid until December 31st of the year they were purchased.

What type of license is best for you

Before you begin the process, you should know the type of license you wish to purchase. Below is a chart which shows which licenses are good for which activities. Notes below on some of the license categories and requirements.

LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

- All members must be covered under a federal or provincial hospital or medical plan.
- A passport-style photo of the license holder (for UCI Race licenses only). Your license will not be issued until a suitable photo has been uploaded.
- All members must sign a waiver. This is done through the online registration process. For riders under 19 years of age, a parent/guardian must sign the electronic assumption of risk.

- All members must choose a primary discipline (BMX- Bicycle Moto Cross | CX- Cyclo-Cross | DH-Downhill | XC- Cross-Country | Road | Track)
- Important note for all UCI Athletes over 35 years old: All athletes aged 35 years or older must decide at the time of license application to compete in either Elite or Master for the entire season. Changes between Master and Elite are only possible at the time of annual license renewal. Mid-season changes between Elite and Master are not possible.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

* You can only select the sports which correspond to your license. For instance you **cannot** add Cyclocross to a MTB/DH/Enduro ONLY license

** Masters 55+ are not valid for BMX. Only UCI BMX Adult, UCI BMX Youth licenses are valid.

*** Must have the appropriate credentials to register for a number of technical license categories

- Coaches must have completed training and/or certification as an NCCP cycling coach.
- Commissaires must have completed training and passed evaluation at the appropriate level.
- Drivers must have successfully completed Cycling Canada's online Caravan Driver Training.

**** Anyone purchasing a technical license in addition to an ABA or UCI license will only pay one license fee, whichever is greater.

Note: UCI license ability categories are NOT CONFIRMED until the license has been processed and issued.

*****Provincial Race licenses do not allow for upgrading, licensees can only race in Novice or Citizen

Registration

After you have clicked on the link to open up the ABA 2023 Membership Registration, you will have 2 options to start the registration process. If you have previously registered a user login with zone 4 you may enter your credentials. If not, click **Add First Person**.

If you have not set up the zone 4 login you will need to enter in all the personal information for the licensee. If you have, please make sure the information is correct and you are registering the correct person (i.e. it is not your information while registering our child).

All information marked with a red asterisk is required information.

*Note- the age is as of the end of the year.



We do allow members to self identify, though the UCI and Cycling Canada currently only recognize male and female, so all UCI licenses must have Male or Female.

Emergency contact is whomever is best to contact you in case of an emergency, this information will be on your license and shared with your club.

The ABA and Cycling Canada recognizes everyone's right to self-identify, If you wish to			
choose a General Membership you may set your gender to <i>unspecified</i> .			
Currently the UCI only recognizes Male or Female genders and as such we are only able to provide UCI licenses categories with a male or female gender. By selecting this option your provincial code only will appear according to the racing category and gender you have chosen. If you would like to participate in UCI sanctioned races, you will be required to race as the gender on your license as UCI and/or any major national or international games organization's regulations regarding transgender or gender neutral athlete participation supersedes all national and provincial regulations. If your club is set up with ABA to register their membership, you may see another box appear which you will need to complete for your club membership. One example is below, but this will change depending on which club you are set up with and what information they require.

Next you will be required to choose your license information, select whichever license best suits your needs at the time of registration.

UCI licenses are required for the BMX Provincial series.

Citizen/Provincial license is only valid for Novice or Citizen categories and only valid in Alberta.

UCI Technical Commissaire licenses are only valid for commissairing and may not be used for club rides, races or any other on bike activities.

Racing Category Selection

If you selected General Membership or U17 General Membership you can skip each step until your reach Waivers & Declarations. Do not fill in the following section.

For any type of racing license you next will need to indicate your racing discipline(s) and the age and ability category you're competing in.

If you have selected a single sport license only, you only fill in the information for the discipline. If you have a cross only license, only fill in Cross, if you have a track only license, only select Track, if you have an MTB only license, only select Enduro, XC or DH, if you have a BMX only license, only select BMX. Other licenses can choose as many disciplines as they may wish to compete in.

Technical licenses do not fill in this part of the registration.

When you click to select your discipline a new set of options will be shown, the options shown will depend on which discipline you are selecting.



In the example above, BMX, the next option is to select Challenge or Championship.

- Challenge- all ages, racing novice, intermediate, expert. The majority of racers will choose challenge
- Championship- Junior (17 &18 yrs. of age), U23(19-22 yrs. of age) Elite (23+), must have been an expert racer before choosing to move to Championship

Once you select the appropriate classification, you will have your age groups, click which ever age and gender category you belong to (age is as of December 31, so if you turn 8 on December 31 you would still choose 8 years old.).

Technical Information

If you are a commissaire, coach, mechanic etc. you will need to fill in the information which pertains to you.

You can skip this selection if you do not participate outside of riding/racing.

Most of these license designations will require specific training, please ensure you have completed all the required courses prior to purchasing your license. We do verify all technical licenses.

Both the Commissaire and Coaching sections require further information.

For Commissaires, unless you have been upgraded by the ABA, please select Provincial C.

For Coaches select the one that matches the coaching courses you have taken, you can verify courses through the locker. Only Cycling coaches are eligible for an ABA coaching license.

Waivers & Declarations

The next section is a series or waivers and declarations required to purchase your license. Waivers will default depending on the age of the person purchasing the license. Anyone under 18 years of age will need their Parental Consent for filled in.

These are all mandatory as indicated with the red asterisk please make sure you take the time to read the information and check the appropriate box. These are often missed, and the registration will not complete without them.

Additional Information/Options

Anyone with a Provincial/Citizen license or UCI license will need to upload a photo. This just needs to be a photo of the licensee's face and should have NO HATS, NO HELMETS, NO SUNGLASSES.

Unsuitable photos will not be used.

If your photo will not upload, you may email it to the ABA.

A new photo is needed each year



The additional options are completely up to the person who is registering.

Plastic copies of your license are only to be checked when they are required by your trade team, Cycling Canada or racing in a country which does not accept digital licenses (although this is a UCI provision).

Additional insurance can be purchased, but is also completely optional. ABA insurance does not include coverage outside of ABA sanctioned events.

Completion

Once you are completed the form, you will need to click continue.

If you are missing a mandatory field, that field will be highlighted in red, and it will not let you continue.

If you have a second person to register, click Add Second Person, the registration will bring you back to the beginning of the registration to add the next person.

After all registrations have been completed click Checkout. Here you will need to select your payment method and then enter your payment details.

Once this is completed, you will be sent a receipt from ZONE 4 to whichever email address you have indicated on the payment page.

Your license will be sent directly to the email address that is associated with each registration.
