Alberta Bicycle Association – Who are we?

The Alberta Bicycle Association (ABA) is an affiliated Provincial Sport Organization (PSO) of Cycling Canada (CC). It operates under the authority of the world governing body of cycling, the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI) in Geneva.

The ABA is a not-for-profit association run by professional staff, relying on membership fees, fundraising, and government support for operating funds. ABA members include road, track, BMX, cyclo-cross, mountain bike, and downhill racing, recreational and transportation, educators, coaches, officials, administrators, enthusiast, volunteers, and advocates of the sport.

Our Mission

The mission of the ABA is to facilitate an introduction to organized cycling and to develop a strong competitive cycling program, while protecting and advocating the rights of cyclists.

Trailblazers Youth Racing — What is it?

The Trailblazers Youth Racing program was developed in early 2013 as a means of encouraging youth of all ages and abilities to try competitive mountain biking. The aim of the program is to make mountain bike racing fully accessible to youth across the Province of Alberta.

In early 2013, youth development was targeted as one of the Alberta Bicycle Association's most important Strategic Objectives in the next five years and beyond. Since youth participation at Alberta Cup Provincial Series races has generally been very low, it was identified that the youth needed a series of their own where the focus is on fun and inclusivity. This led to the development of the Trailblazers Youth Racing program. The proposed series identifies several key principles that will be the focal point for attracting new riders to the sport. They are:

ಈ FUN keeping the experience positive so youth continue to come back ★ Accessibility Removing barriers to entry for youth of all ages and abilities

giving youth the choice to choose a race that suits their specific abilities

Trailblazers Youth Racing acknowledges the fact that regardless of age or gender, each individual child develops at a different rate. It's for this reason that this race series will give youth the choice – at each and every event – to race the event that matches their own specific comfort levels. Trailblazers will not assign participants to specific race categories based on their age or gender; rather give them the freedom to choose their race. Participants will have the choice to race one of four separate race-course offerings of varying technical difficulties suited to their individual skill levels.

Trailblazers Youth Racing will have a regional focus. The 2013 series will pilot in the Capital region of Edmonton & surrounding municipalities, and Kananaskis Region stretching from Canmore as far as Calgary. The ultimate goal is to see growth of the series across every major region in Alberta.











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The W's

What?

A provincially supported regional mountain bike series targeted directly at youth aged 16 and under (U17). This race series will occur completely separate from the currently-established Alberta Cup Provincial Series and offering a fun, low pressure alternative for youth looking to try out racing.

Where?

The ultimate goal of the series is to encompass each of the 8 Provincial Zones as outlined by the Alberta Summer Games – effectively the entire province of Alberta. The series will take on a "regional" format, with numerous pre-specified regions hosting independent youth series' across the province (i.e. "Capital Region Youth Series" encompassing Edmonton and Surrounding area). For 2013, the program will be established in the "Capital Region" and the "Kananaskis Region".

Why?

Cycling is a popular sport amongst youth in Alberta, yet we continue to see extremely low numbers in youth racing. As a part of our youth initiative, we hope to offer this series as a FUN way to expose youth to racing. We feel that offering a series completely independent of the Alberta Cup will reduce the intimidation involved with being a first-time racer. Such a series will ideally encourage more Alberta clubs to offer youth programs in the coming years.

Who?

Racers: youth aged 16 and under
Organizers: Local volunteers and clubs
Support: Alberta Bicycle Association

When?

The proposed series will occur ideally from the months of May through as late as September. The proposed format will see races happening during weeknights or on weekends based on venue and organizer availability.

An ideal Regional Series will see a minimum of one race per month from the months of May to August. The targeted growth of this series will see at minimum one region added each year until the Province is fully encompassed.

How?

The Alberta Bicycle Association will drive the framework of the series by handling all advertizing, calendar construction and insurance/sanction requests. Organizers and local volunteers will be responsible for administering the events and attracting local participants.











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Why get involved?

The Trailblazers Youth Racing program is a perfect initiative to demonstrate your support of healthy active living amongst youth in Alberta. With recent Canadian international success, cycling has received a great deal of media and public exposure in Canada. More than ever, youth are inspired to pick up their bicycles and try racing. This program allows them to do just that.

Some of the added benefits to sponsoring the Trailblazers Youth Racing program:

Targeted regions:

Each specific region within Alberta will have its very own race series. Becoming a partner of the Trailblazers Youth Racing program will give your brand direct access to every region within the series.

Direct access to youth demographic:

The Trailblazers Youth Racing Series will give your brand direct exposure to not only a "youth-tailored" race series, but a *cause* dedicated to increasing the number of active, healthy youth in our province. Due to the fact that many of the youth in this series are still quite young, we expect that parents will be a large part of the demographic as well, helping out with volunteer duties and spectating the races.

Support a good cause:

By helping support the Trailblazers Youth Racing program, your organization is telling the world "yes, we believe in the importance of supporting healthy, active youth initiatives". By signing on as a Trailblazers Youth Racing partner you will be given full access to the Trailblazers brand, giving you the opportunity to activate your support in any future marketing initiatives.

Cycling's increase in popularity

Following the 2012 London Olympic Games, Cycling Canada revised it's overall mission for Canada to be "a leading cycling nation by the year 2020". Every Olympic athlete must start somewhere and has a fond memory of their very first experience in their sport – why not associate your brand with that memory? Trailblazers Youth Racing could be that very starting place for our country's future Olympic champions.

With top-level International cycling events making their way to our own backyard, cycling as a sport is gaining increased media exposure beyond the usual suspects such as the Tour de France. Also new for 2013, the province will be welcoming the <u>Tour of Alberta</u> – the highest Internationally sanctioned cycling event in Canada. This event will be fully televised on Sportsnet and anticipates unprecedented local support. Event organizers plan to maintain this event for many years to come, which will only build on local fan base and interest in our sport. Naturally we expect that an event with such scale covering the entire province will inspire youth of all ages to give racing a try. Trailblazers Youth Racing represents an opportunity to get involved at the ground level of a new era of cycling in Alberta.











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Customized Marketing Opportunities

The Trailblazers Program will see extensive promotion in the coming years in line with the Alberta Bicycle Association's Strategic Plan to increase youth involvement in the sport of cycling. As a result of this, your brand's association with the program will have the opportunity for exposure in the following ways:

Social Media

The ABA's social media pages are currently utilized as one of the top ways to spread information to our membership and beyond. It is anticipated that the Association's Twitter following will see growth to 1000+ followers by the summer of 2013, added to our combined Facebook following of over 1100 users. The Alberta Bicycle Association has a direct membership of 3000+ cycling enthusiasts. During peak months of the cycling season, the ABA sends newsletters directly to our members on a weekly basis via email.

Promotional Posters

At the beginning of each race season, the Alberta Bicycle Association will circulate promotional Trailblazers Youth Racing posters to all regions within the perimeter of the series'. The targeted locations identified for poster placement are:

- ♣ Local Bike Shops
- Existing cycling clubhouses
- Municipal buildings & recreation complexes within the region

Event Race Plates

All participants taking part in the Trailblazers Youth Race Series will receive a race number plate designed by the Alberta Bicycle Association. Race number plates are perhaps the number one most important keepsake for the youth who race in this series. Following most youth races, it's common practice for youth to keep their number plates fastened securely to their handlebars as a means of showing off to friends and saying "check it out! I race mountain bikes!". We look at these number plates as a way of further











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promoting the series and encouraging more people to get involved. This will increase the visibility of your brand beyond the series itself and into the communities where youth actively ride their bikes.

Promotional merchandise

Dependant on sponsorship dollars raised, the Alberta Bicycle Association may purchase various promotional items to distribute amongst participants. This may include items such as: water bottles, tshirts, participant medals, hats, stickers, etc. Sponsors at the Gold and Silver levels will have the opportunity for logo placement on all promotional merchandise.


